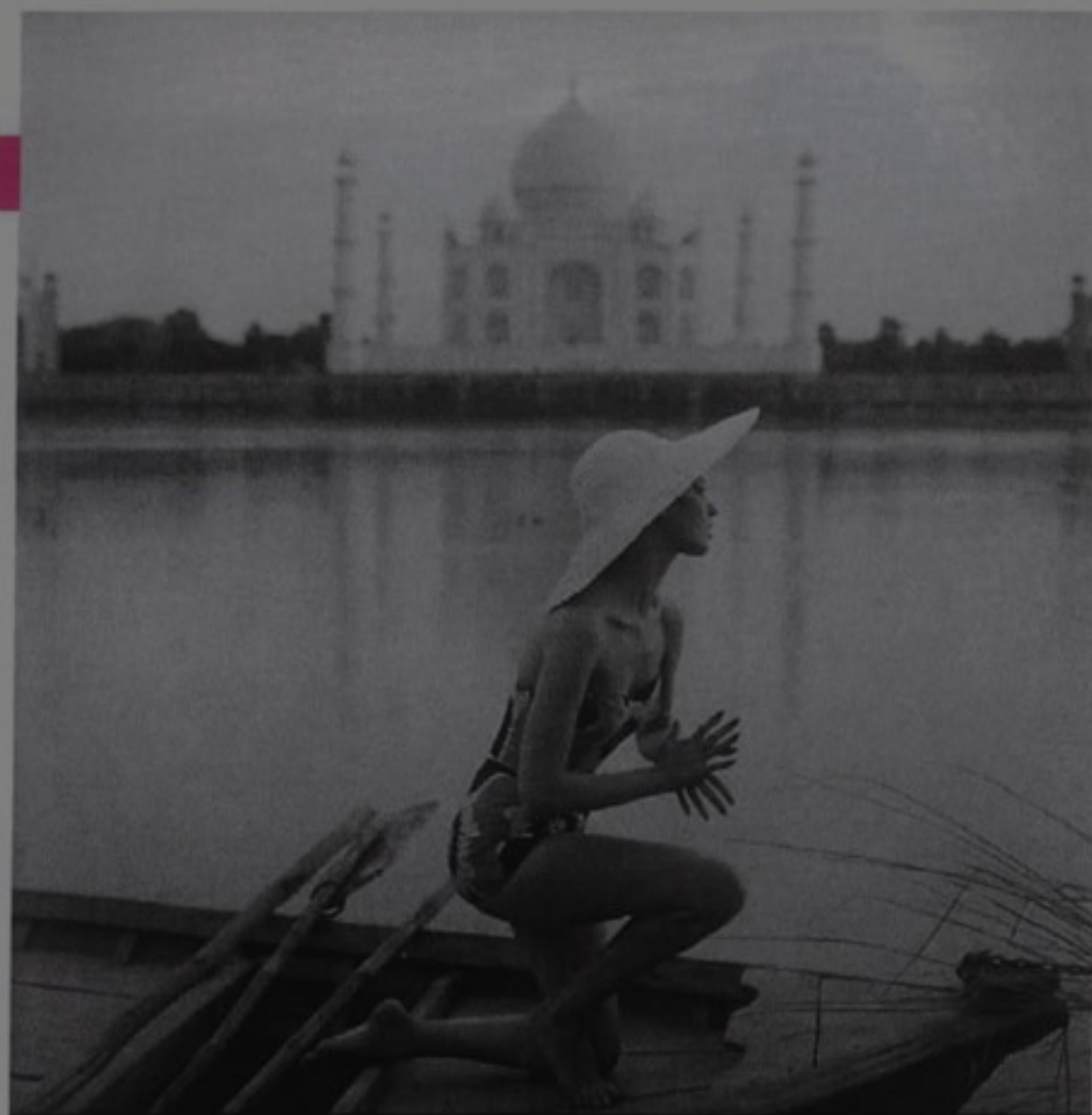

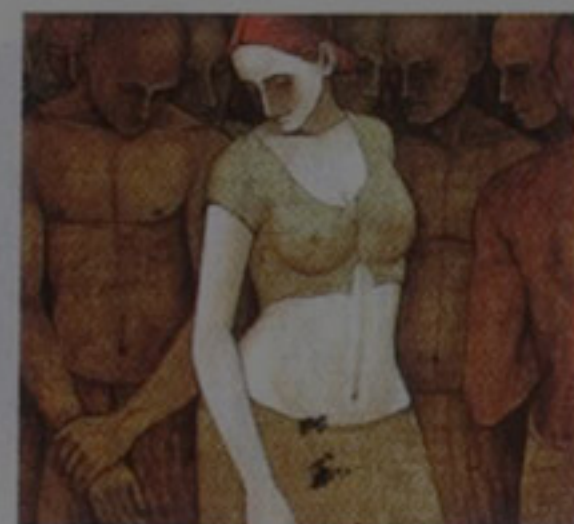
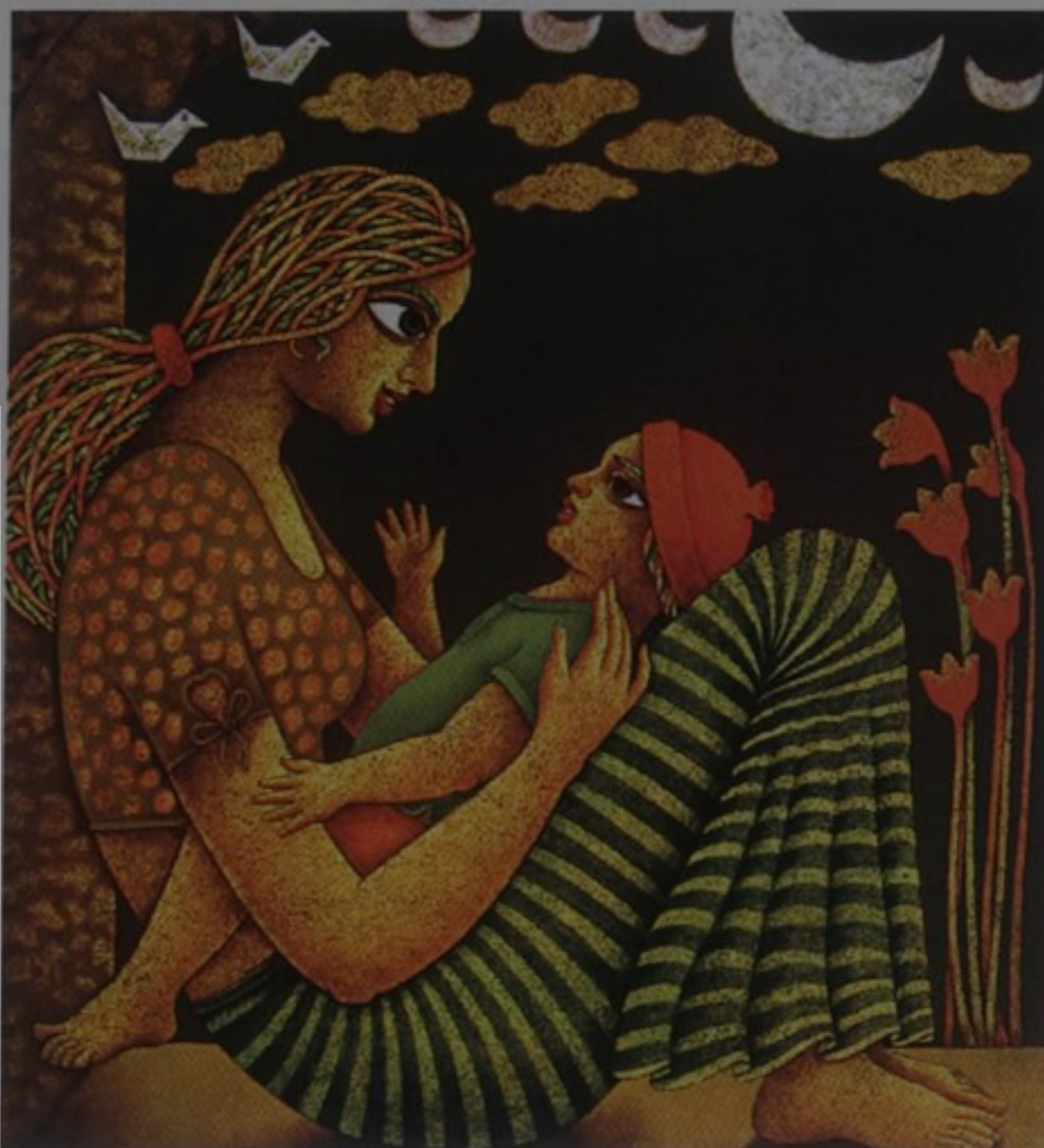
Pink is the Navy Blue of India by Norman Parkinson
